Mangonui Waterfront Boardwalk

The Mangonui Waterfront Development Working Group is continuing to work with FNDC and Far North Holdings on plans for the development of waterfront facilities.

These include:

- An extension of the boardwalk
- A walkway right around past the Old Oak to Maori Point
- New jetties and pleasure craft landing facilities.

Although there is still more than a year to get this work under way to avoid a full length extension of the safety railing, this will take time and there is therefore urgency to get the planning and consent stages completed, FNDC have approved funds for planning, and so the land and sea bed surveys have been commissioned.
